PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I would move to adopt the E & R amendments for LB 182.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, the question before you is the adoption of the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed say nay. LB 182 advances. Excuse me, the amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, the first amendment I have to the bill, Senator Warner, AM0386, Senator. It's found on page 747 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President and members of the Legislature, this amendment is a corrective amendment. There was a three...this was three bills put together on the deal with the collection of fuel tax and there was a section that was...originally was LB 183 that had the emergency clause, but with an operative date of July 1, and when the bills were combined, this section, and this deals with reefers on trucks, this section that had a...it dealt with that in combination with the operative date and the emergency clause. This section got dropped so it would take effect immediately upon passage of the bill. It should be July 1. So what...all this amendment does is put an operative date July 1 for the section that deals with reefers on trucks, which was the manner in which the bill was introduced, but when we combined them, that operative date was not included. So I move adoption of that amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you. Is there any discussion of the Warner amendment? Seeing none, Senator Warner, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the Warner amendment to LB 182. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Warner amendment is adopted. Anything
