

February 28, 1995 LB 297, 420

Withem's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Withem amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I would move to advance LB 420 to E & R final.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Any discussion? Seeing none, the question before you is the advancement of LB 420. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. LB 420 advances. LB 297.

CLERK: 297, no E & R. Senator Beutler would move to amend.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Members of the Legislature, this is purely a technical amendment and it really deals with the part of the bill that is not even related to the intent of 297 but rather relates to a part of the bill that was corrected by the bill drafters simply because we were in that section of statutes and that portion needed some redrafting. In doing that, it was a portion that related to banking practices and doing that, the banks were a little bit concerned about the reading of the bill drafters language in one portion and so all this does, it doesn't change the meaning or intent of the current law, but rather uses different words to make clear a particular portion of LB 297, but again it constitutes no change whatsoever from the current law. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Is there any further discussion of the Beutler amendment? Seeing none, Senator Beutler, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to LB 297. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Beutler amendment is adopted.
