SENATOR SCHIMEK: Well, Senator, I...let's go back to your previous question.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: That's not really a question that I expect you to answer.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I think the single...the single person, I think, refers to either a man or a woman.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Okay.
