

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And...

SENATOR BEUTLER: And that's my intent although it also is my intent that out of the conversation, out of that conversation up or down on the proposal, in the event that there are constitutional amendments, will come some meaningful dialogue on those constitutional amendments.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right. Since my time is almost up, I will put on my light but I won't ask you any more at this time. Thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Chambers, you may continue, your light is next.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this is not to question Senator Beutler further at this point, but Senator Wehrbein had made a comment to which Senator Witek responded, and her response indicated that this is not just an ordinary meeting and made some additional comments which established that what she said is true. But in this document or packet of information that the Governor sent to us under cover of that January 30th, 1995 memorandum that I had mentioned earlier, if you turn to what is marked capital A, with an Arabic 1 in a circle under that A, as the identification of the page, the heading of that page is Conference of the States, underlined, then beneath that a subhead, An Action Plan for balanced competition in the federal system. Then below that the words, a brief summary. About midway down the page, this is what you find. A legal entity called the Conference of the States, Inc will be formed when a significant majority of states pass resolutions of participation. So this is a legal entity with an identification and I don't know whether they are going to have offices. Senator Kristensen, are you on the floor? Is this organization, this legal entity called the Conference of the States which will be created, will it have a board of directors or just who will comprise this corporation?

SENATOR HALL: Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Senator Chambers, I believe that that, you are correct that it will be incorporated a nonprofit corporation. It will have a board of directors. I assume that that board of directors would be chosen from the delegates or would be chosen when they initially meet that first time.
