SENATOR CROSBY: No objections? So ordered. We'll pass over the Bohlke amendment. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Schimek would move to amend with AMO783.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Schimek, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body, I also am going to ask to pass over this amendment. I'll tell you before I do though, just a little bit about what the amendment does. The amendment frankly plays with the figures a little bit more and I'm not sure that I even want to put it before the body. I guess I'm going to have a better sense of whether the body is satisfied with the numbers that we have before us now in LR 6CA. You know I've heard a lot of different discussion over the last few months, some people feeling that we should go back to the figures pre- Dugan, some people trying to or feeling that we should up the figures from what they were before and stick more with what we have now which is essentially 90 some thousand and so I prepared this amendment which pretty much puts the figures right in the middle of where they had been and where they are now and I'm not sure that I support that, but I prepared the amendment in anticipation that other people would want to do something about it. So I would like to at this time withdraw this amendment and wait until Select File and see if there is further discussion on the numbers and see if there's any further discussion actually on the base on which we have established the numbers. So with that I would like to pass over the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: No objections? So ordered. The amendment is passed over.

CLERK: Madam President, I have nothing further pending to the bill.
