With that I would like to go ahead and again say that I hope that LR 6 advances to Select File and remind the body that this is not Final Reading. Senator Elmer, I know that my good friend, Senator Elmer, has some concerns on registered voters and there are certainly amendments that can be filed on Select File, but if we don't move the bill and at some point get a passage of this bill, we need to remind ourselves that the numbers that are currently in place now that are higher than what the public anticipated would be the numbers that would remain and though some members of the body would like to see that such as Senator Wesely, I think the majority of us would like to bring some type of rationality and stability back to that process and I think this bill at this point does that and again, I appreciate Senator Dierks' support and would move advancement of the bill as well and, Senator Dierks, thank you for a minute of your time.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. You've now heard the final closing on LR 6. The question is the advancement of LR 6 to E & R Initial. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.
