But I think it's a decision that the body of the Legislature needs to make is whether or not that the proof of insurance which actually proves nothing other, well, it doesn't even prove that you have insurance at the time of registration because if your policy comes due within 30 days of the time your license needs...or your vehicle needs to be reregistered, your insurance company will send you, along with your notice of renewal, a current insurance, proof of insurance and you can...the calendar will work out so that you can have in your possession a current proof and not have a valid insurance policy on your vehicle. So, with that, Mr. Clerk, I would withdraw this amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is withdrawn. We are...anything further on the committee amendments?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: For discussion on the committee amendments, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I want to ask Senator Kristensen some questions, if I may. And, before I ask him, I'm going to...the bill doesn't make sense to me and I'm going to oppose everything with reference to it because I didn't like this idea in the first place of criminalizing conduct when the purpose is to provide guaranteed income for the insurance companies. But, Senator Kristensen, the committee...I don't know if it's the committee amendment or a part of the bill, but it talks about this bold face statement about a person certifying that he or she will maintain, during the entire period of registration, this insurance. Is that...and the failure to maintain it, for that full period, is a misdemeanor. Is that correct?

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: That's under Senator Coordsen's bill, that's not part of the committee amendment, unless...unless I'm not tracking with what you're telling me.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So then this listing on the committee report does not represent amendments that the committee is offering, it's just...
