

keep the provision that you've got to go to the county treasurer. Point two is that the bill reinstates the household...the elimination of the household exclusion which would be maintaining the current law. Senator Landis, I think, gave you a good explanation of that and we would hope that that's not the purpose of the bill and I think it's good to take it back to where we have always been. And I don't believe that was Senator Coordsen's intent to change that. The third point is that we change from the word "swear" and insert the word "certify", that you certify that you're going to have proof of insurance during the period of registration of the vehicle. That's important because if you certify, it makes it easier for enforcement and it more accurately reflects what you're doing. And the final provision is that while you have a vehicle with in transit, decals or your in transit stickers that you also have proof of insurance. We feel that that's an important product as we have lengthened out the period of time for in transit decals and in transit usage that you need to have as good public policy proof of insurance and insurance on the vehicle at that time. Those are the four points and I would urge the adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 37. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on the committee amendments to LB 37. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendments are adopted. Senator Coordsen, would you like to open on LB 37?

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President, and members of the body, we covered briefly in the discussion over the committee amendments the content of LB 37. LB 37, as in its amended version now, has restored to it the necessity to have an effective proof of insurance, a valid proof of insurance at the time of registration. In addition, LB 37 requires that a statement in bold face print that an automobile liability policy or proof of financial responsibility is required in Nebraska, and by paying the required registration fee every person whose name appears on the title certifies that he or she will maintain a current and effective automobile liability policy during the
