LB 300, 430

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 300.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 300 is advanced. Would like to recognize guests of Senator Lindsay. I believe they're in the balcony. We have Beverly DeMauro from Creighton University. She has 24 students from Tokoha University in Shizouko, Japan and their teacher. Would you please stand and be recognized. LB 430, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, 430 introduced by Senator Schellpeper. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 17, referred to the Revenue Committee, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Warner, on the committee amendments.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this committee amendment simply adds an operative date of October 1 of 1995 for the provisions of the bill, as Senator Schelipeper will explain. It essentially deals with an issue of whether the component parts that go into the manufacturing of steel and the process that he will shortly describe is...should not be covered by sales tax as input rather than the ruling that has been held that it's not what the product is...either becomes a part of the manufactured item or becomes a part of the slag, which in either case is sold and on that basis it would be a component part. But the committee amendment simply puts an operative date. So I would move adoption of that.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Warner. Senator Schellpeper, on the committee amendment.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and members, I rise to support the committee amendments. It puts the date of October 1 in. We should have put that in the bill. We didn't. I'll explain the bill once we get the committee amendments adopted. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Schellpeper. No further lights, is there closing, Senator Warner? I assume not. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
