SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Beutler, are you finished, or...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Okay, thank you. Any further discussion? Senator Schellpeper, there is none, would you care to close?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and members, once again this bill is very important for Nucor Steel. It's a very large employer in northeast Nebraska. I would sure welcome anyone to come up and go through that plant. They would be very...you would be very welcome up there. I know some people have been through it. Senator Firsch has gone through it. It's just a fantastic large plant and it employs lots of individuals. But this bill is designed so that they only pay the tax one time. As Senator Day stated, they are a very large taxpayer and they are not complaining about paying it once, but they don't think they should have to pay a sales tax twice and that's what LB 430 does. I move for the advancement. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Schellpeper. The question is, shall LB 430 advance? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Well, I guess I really hate to have a call of the house, but I'm probably going to have to ask for a...okay.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 430.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 430 advances. LB 494.

CLERK: LB 494, Mr. President, introduced by Senator Fisher. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 17, referred to the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee, advanced to General File. I do have amendments by the Banking Committee, Mr. President.
