

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 275A is advanced. LB 307, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 307, Mr. President, introduced by Senators Hall and Withem. (Read title.) The bill was introduced in January, referred to the Executive Board for hearing, advanced to General File. The bill has been discussed, Mr. President, on February 28, and again on March 2nd. Senator Avery had an amendment pending, Mr. President, when the Legislature left the issue last time. Senator Avery is excused until he arrives, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Is anybody prepared to handle the Avery amendment? If not, we will pass that...pass over the Avery amendment. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The motion then...Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I'd move the advancement of LB 307 to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any further discussion? Seeing none Senator Hall, do you have closing? The question is the advancement of LB 307. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: I'd ask for a call of the house.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. Members, record your presence. Unauthorized parties leave the floor. Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Accept call-in votes.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Call-in votes have been accepted, will be accepted.

CLERK: Senator Landis, you had voted yes, Senator. Senator Robinson voting yes. Senator Kristensen voting yes. Senator
