

SPEAKER WITHEM: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. Members, return to the Chamber. Members, sign in. The house is under call. We're voting on the Lindsay amendment. Call-in votes have been authorized, Senator Lindsay, do I understand?

CLERK: Senator Coordsen voting yes. Senator Hillman voting yes.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Lindsay's amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The Lindsay amendment is adopted. The call is raised. Mr. Clerk, what else do we have?

CLERK: Nothing further pending to the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Nothing pending on the committee amendments, we're back to discussion. I believe we have had the opening on the committee amendments so we're back to discussing the committee amendments. Any discussion? Senator Lindsay, do you have closing?

CLERK: 25 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.
