I do not believe that this amendment makes great substantive change. If it did, I would have done it through committee and that's the reason I'm doing this to harmonize. So, with that, I would urge the adoption of this amendment to the Standing Committee amendments.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I would waive. Thank you.
