LB 178, 275A, 668

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. Speaker, I would move to advance LB 275A to E & R final.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the motion. Any discussion? The question then is the advancement of LB 275A. All those in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. We're in somewhat of a dilemma. Senator Schimek is not here. The next bill is one of those to be advanced without amendments and LR 6CA will take a considerable amount of time. I believe LB 17 follows that, LB 712, excuse me, follows that and I understand that would be an extensive debate on that one with some amendments needing to be drafted yet. LB 37 I understand there's some amendments on so I think what we'll do, Mr. Clerk, unless the body objects strenuously to this procedure, will be we'll take up those bills without amendments and then entertain a motion to recess, so, Mr. Clerk, why don't we proceed with LB 668.

CLERK: 668, Senator Maurstad, I have no amendments to the bill, Senator.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. Speaker, I would move to advance LB 668 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any discussion? Seeing none, the question is, shall LB 668 be advanced? All in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. LB 178, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 178, Senator, I have Enrollment and Review amendments.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. Speaker, I would move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 178.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the motion. All in favor of adopting the E & R amendments say aye. Opposed. They are adopted. Mr. Clerk.
