SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: (Microphone not activated immediately.) ...Legislative Chamber. Roll call, will the senators please check in.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Do you have any items for the record?

CLERK: I do, thank you. Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined engrossed LB 136 and find the same correctly engrossed, LB 136A I should say, excuse me; LB 20A, LB 182A, LB 401A, all reported correctly engrossed. Senator Vrtiska would like to print amendments to LB 307; Senator Kristensen to LB 377 and LB 424. That's all that I have, Madam President. (See pages 1235-42 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. We will proceed with LR 16. Mr. Clerk, would you tell us where we are on LR 16.

CLERK: Madam President, LR 16, originally introduced by Senator Kristensen and others. (Read summary.) The resolution was referred to the Executive Board for hearing, advanced to the Legislature for further discussion. It was discussed on March 1 and March 7. A series of amendments have been adopted. I do have other amendments pending at this time, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Kristensen, would you like to do just a brief reintroduction of the resolution, then we'll go on with the amendment.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Madam President, members of the Legislature. LR 16 is a resolution which would authorize the participation of this state in a process called The Conference
