That's the wording that sets up the parameters of where this group will go and the specifics of how they'll do that, obviously, is yet to be determined.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But, Senator...oh.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: But you can't do that until you get everybody together, I think.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But, Senator Kristensen, where do we see, since they are talking about the States' Petition in the resolution, anything which says in the resolution that should that petition, or whatever the document will ultimately be called, contain proposals to amend the Constitution, it would require a vote by a supermajority of the legislatures to keep that provision as a part of the document?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: And, Senator, I will tell you that that's not in this resolution. Now, I also will tell you that I've looked at Senator Withem's amendment here within the last half hour, 45 minutes, and that does seek to address that in a procedural manner, and that might be something I could live with.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would you be opposed...well, no, you already stated that. And I won't ask you those questions because when I reach a point of asking you the ones about the organization, I want them to be, like I say, in a package and not helter-skelter, here and there. And it...should anybody want to read about our debate on this matter, as I have read various debates on constitutional provisions relative to the U.S. Constitution and even some federal laws, it's helpful if segments of the item are discussed as segments so the thoughts that people have relative to those won't be mixed and
