

and the only thing I want to do is ask Senator Kristensen how he feels about my amendment to Senator Witek's amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Senator Chambers, to the extent I'm going to support your amendment, it cleans up, I think, not a very well-worded phrase in there and I certainly would support that. I'm not going to vote for, obviously, the amendment, but your amendment makes good sense and it's also provided us a vehicle to discuss the issue and I think that's been helpful.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And, Madam President, since it takes 25 votes even to amend an amendment to an amendment where a resolution is involved, I would ask for a call of the house and I'll take a machine vote.

SENATOR CROSBY: There's a request for a call of the house. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SENATOR CROSBY: The house is under call. Will all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Will all senators please check in. Record your presence. Would all senators who are not in the Chamber please return and record your presence. Senator Vrtiska, would you like to check in. Senator Avery, Senator Beutler, Senator Bernard-Stevens. Senator Lindsay, Senator Lynch, Senator Matzke. Senator McKenzie, Senator Bromm, Senator Brashear. Senator Preister, Senator Robak, Senator Fisher. Senator Hall, Senator Hillman, Senator Hudkins. Senator Wickersham and Senator Jensen...Janssen, Senator Janssen. Senator Wickersham, would you please return to the Chamber. The house is under call. The question is the Chambers amendment to the Witek amendment on LR 16. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of the amendment to the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The Chambers amendment is adopted. I will raise the call. Okay, Mr. Clerk, do you have some items for the record?

CLERK: Madam President, thank you. Transportation Committee
