SENATOR CHAMBERS: I understand, but this is the very reason, what we're talking about, that I wanted some specific things in the resolution to make it clear what our position as a Legislature would be. Once this organization gets up and running, there is nothing, I don't believe, Nebraska can do to stop them from doing whatever they choose to do.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Well, but...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And our only salvation will be what we put in our resolution.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Well, and we've done that in a resolution. Remember, we made those changes that Senator Beutler had, if you'll remember and look at his amendment,...
