

And the ones bringing this together said that the name of the entity will be The Conference of State Governments, Inc.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And my understanding was that the states, the legislatures will be the ones comprising this organization. And if that is true, my amendment is designed to terminate our participation as a member of that corporation. But if there were other things the Legislature would do as a Legislature, that could continue.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, so anything that's authorized with respect to any kind of participation, whether it be in the legal entity, or whether it be in an activity known as a conference sponsored by that legal entity, anything that could be participated in by a representative of the State of Nebraska or a delegation from the State of Nebraska is intended by your amendment to be terminated under the terms of the amendment. Is that correct?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, all mine does is to terminate Nebraska as a member of that corporation, of that entity.

SENATOR BEUTLER: But our delegation could continue to participate in an...

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...activity sponsored by that organization?

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Call the question.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: That will not be necessary, Senator, yours is the last light or. Senator Chambers, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Beutler's questions again point out gaps in what it is that we're talking about, and nobody, even those who support the resolution, can give us answers.
