

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And that's why I'm asking this blunt, direct question, which I'd like a blunt, direct answer from you on. We don't know which states and how states will be allowed to become members, do we?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: We don't know which states will become members because we don't know who's voted to be part of the participation.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And other than those who send a resolution prior to the convening of this conference, we don't even know how states become members, if there's some way other than this, do we?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: All we know is that at the beginning they're going to incorporate.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And we don't know how a state which does not send a resolution becomes a member of the corporation, or even if they can, do we?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: We know that the original ones will do that. Do we know what's going to happen after they incorporate and whether they're going to have people that will be able to join on, no, we don't know that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right, so there is a lot that we're talking about, even though we don't know the answers to very basic questions. We're speculating about most of what we're discussing, aren't we.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Senator, we could speculate as to whether you and I are going to get home tonight.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But that's not what I...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: We don't know that, do we?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But I haven't put forth a document to ask you all to sign it saying that I'm going to get home. You're asking us to vote formally for a document, the meaning of which even you don't know.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: That's not true.
