

SENATOR CHAMBERS: All right, then how...can other states become members of this corporation if they don't send one of these resolutions in prior to the convening of the conference?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: To the best of my knowledge, no.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But you don't know that for sure, do you?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Senator, to the best of my knowledge, that's my answer.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, thank you. He doesn't know the answer and he's embarrassed when he shouldn't be. He ought to just admit he doesn't know the answer. Not only does he not know whether other states can become members, presuming that they can, he doesn't know how they would become members. He doesn't know whether a state which does not send a resolution can send delegates, he doesn't know that. And he doesn't know whether a state which did not send resolutions but would send delegates will be turned away at the door. He doesn't know that. He doesn't know who will be on the board of directors. He doesn't know how the board of directors will be put together. He doesn't know any of those things. And he doesn't know the meaning of resolution of participation, and if he does, he'll tell us. But the difference between me and a lot of people is that I won't let somebody put me out on a limb and talk more than I know. See, some people know more than they say, others say more than they know. And when people say more than they know and their hand is called, rather than just admitting, well I didn't know, I thought I did but I don't know, they've got to pretend that they know. So they give the temporizing statements and comments which are not productive in terms of the information we are trying to arrive at. I'm not going to support the resolution. I'm offering a motion to kill it. If people intend to not vote for this resolution, they ought to vote for this motion. But they can do whatever they want to, and I know that's what will happen. There is information which was given us by the Governor's people who support this resolution, and the information is different from what is contained in the resolution. The information they gave us on this very page that you find information is at least inconsistent if not contradictory. Fewer than a constitutional majority of the states, whatever that means, and Senator Kristensen doesn't know and I don't know, constitutional majority of the states to do what?
