PRESIDENT ROBAK: Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the first of the Natural Resources Committee confirmation report. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the first confirmation report.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The first Natural Resources confirmation report is adopted. The Chair recognizes Senator Beutler for the second confirmation report.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Madam President, the committee suggests that two appointments to the Central Interstate Low-Level Radioactive Waste Commission be confirmed. Those would be the appointments of Mr. Gregory Hayden and Mr. Craig Zeisler, both of whom withstood the probing, withering questioning by the committee.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Is there any discussion of the second Natural Resources Committee confirmation report? Seeing none, Senator Beutler, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the second Natural Resources Committee confirmation report. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.
