SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Any further discussion on the confirmation report? Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Madam President, members, just so you don't hold it against this fellow who I don't know at all, there is no relationship, so it's okay to go ahead and vote for him. At least there's one Hall that can get appointed around here. Thank you. (Laughter.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Hall. Any further discussion? Seeing none, Senator Wickersham, would you like to close? He waives closing. The question is the adoption of the confirmation report from the Retirement Committee. All in favor say aye...vote aye, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the confirmation report as offered by Retirement Systems.

SENATOR CROSBY: The report is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: The last report, Madam President, by the Revenue Committee involves the appointment of Mr. Cliff Welsh. It's found on page 1170 of the Journal.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, Madam President, I move adoption of the committee report recommending that Mr. Welsh be appointed to the Nebraska Agricultural Land Valuation Advisory Board. He's from Brule, Nebraska. He's been...currently he's county commissioner, also has been on the Nebraska Natural Resource Commission for a number of years, past chairman, and NRD board member locally, extension board, a number of activities and well qualified to be on this advisory board of the valuation of ag land. I did not happen to be present at the hearing but I have visited with Mr. Welsh on other occasions and certainly strongly concur in the committee's recommendation of his approval, and would have also voted yes had I been there that day. But I would urge the body to confirm this appointment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Warner. Any discussion on the confirmation report from the Revenue Committee? Seeing none, Senator Warner. He waives closing. The question is the adoption of the confirmation report from the Revenue Committee. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.
