

CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. Members, please return to the floor. Unauthorized parties please leave the floor. Members, please record your presence. We are under call. Senator McKenzie, how shall we proceed?

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Call-in votes will be fine, thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Call-in votes have been authorized. Senator Fisher, can you check in, please.

CLERK: Senator Lynch voting yes. Senator Fisher voting yes.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Waiting for Senator Preister, Senator Warner and Senator Wickersham.

CLERK: Senator Wickersham voting yes.

SPEAKER WITHEM: We are voting on the advancement of LB 377A. Call-in votes have been authorized.

CLERK: Senator Schrock voting yes. Senator Maurstad voting yes. Senator Warner voting yes. Senator Bohlke voting yes.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to advance the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 377A is advanced. The call is raised. LB 405A, Senator Wesely.

CLERK: LB 406A, a bill by Senator Wesely. (Read title.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, those of you who are present anyway, LB 406A, LB 406 deals with the...it's the clean-up bill from the Health Department, so the A bill is to fund those elements. The major part of LB 406 in terms of funding is a raise in the fee on vital statistics to then improve the machinery that is used to retrieve vital statistics, and so that is all cash funded. There's a \$289,000 cash fund appropriation with this A bill.
