SPEAKER WITHEM: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. Members, please record your presence. Return to the Chamber. Unauthorized parties leave the floor, the house is under call. When all members not excused are present, we will have a roll call vote on the adoption of the Bernard-Stevens amendment. Senator Chambers, could you check in, please. Senator Cudaback, could you check in. Senator Bohlke, could you return to the floor, please. Mr. Clerk, is it still Senator Bohlke we are looking for? All members not excused are present. The question is the adoption of the Bernard-Stevens amendment. Proceed to call the roll, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1315 of the Legislative Journal.) 17 ayes, 15 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The Bernard-Stevens amendment is not adopted. The call is raised. Mr. Clerk, anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, I do. Senator Wesely would move to indefinitely postpone the bill. Senator Beutler has the option to lay the bill over, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Lay it over, Mr. Speaker.
