

offered to the bill itself. And I'd like to ask Senator Wickersham, if he's here, a question, if I may, to determine how much I might say about the committee amendment. Senator Wickersham, does your amendment, which I really haven't had a chance to thoroughly digest, contain the language relative to confidentiality or the privileged nature of this material that would have been in the amended version of the committee amendments?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: No, Senator, that would be struck. The process in the amendment that will be offered later, amendment 1246, I think is what you're referring to,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Uh-huh.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: ...is explicitly a public process, it is part of the public hearing.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, thank you. I don't know what value there is going to be to adopting the committee amendments, if people are of a mind to adopt Senator Wickersham's amendment. But on the chance that his hasn't been reviewed, maybe adopting the committee amendment is a worthwhile thing. But, Senator Jones, I see the whole kit and caboodle as something unworthy of being adopted. So at this point I'm not going to either vote for or against adoption of the committee amendment. We'll see what form the bill is going to take or what direction the discussion relative to the bill itself will take.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Chambers. There are no further lights on. Senator Janssen, close on the committee amendments? Closing has been waived. Question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Question before the body is the adoption of the committee amendments. Senator Janssen.
