

Review amendments have been considered and adopted. Senator McKenzie offered AM1076 which is found on page 1207 of the Journal. There was an amendment offered to that by Senator McKenzie, that was adopted. I do have other amendments to that amendment pending, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator McKenzie, would you just take a couple of minutes to explain AM1076 to us?

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and members of the body, if you will recall, AM1076 was offered with a number of technical changes, none of which were substantial in terms of the original content of the committee amendment, however, which was adopted in first round of debate. Basically, we were changing some language so that we were in compliance and harmonized with other language used dealing with the collection of excise tax as currently is done now under the commodity boards. We also had deleted some language with reference to a section dealing with commodity boards that was no longer necessary and it was, in some way, conflicting. I believe that's where we were, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator McKenzie. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Bernard-Stevens has the first amendment to AM1076. Senator, I do have a note that you wish to withdraw and offer AM1166.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: I would like to offer a substitute, if I wish...
