

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1360-61 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is not adopted. The call is raised. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schimek would move to amend with AM0783.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Schimek. Senator Schimek, on your amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Withdraw.

SPEAKER WITHEM: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Dierks would move to amend, Mr. President. (See AM1099 found on page 1361 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: Mr. Speaker, I would like to substitute for my amendment the amendment that Senator Beutler has.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Request has been made for a substitution, is there any objection?
