This that is being offered to us cannot settle the dispute or have any bearing on the dispute between the two private landowners because neither one was acting pursuant to a state rule or regulation. It cannot affect any determination made by the Corps of Engineers because that is a federal agency. So what we have here is something that has nothing to do with the issue that upset Senator Jones. He's being bitten by mosquitos, so he wants them to kill all the alligators in the Okefenokee Swamp. (Laughter.) That's what we're being asked to do. This doesn't make sense. And we should not enact it when the reason for something...

SPEAKER WITHEM: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...has no bearing on what is to be done, that which is offered is not a supporting reason. What we should pass legislation for is to deal with problems that can be addressed by the legislation. This does not address in any way any aspect of the problem that Senator Jones had in his district, but again as a favor the Legislature is going to put into law something that cannot solve the problem that Senator Jones has in his district. It can go to court, it can go to federal court, and nothing that we do in this Legislature is going to resolve it anyway, certainly not putting an additional burden on a state...
