

SPEAKER WITHEM: Record, Mr. Clerk. I'm sorry, I misspoke there, we are not recording at this point. We are still accepting call-in votes. We are still under call. We're looking for absent members of the Chamber. Senator Jones, for what purpose do you rise? Okay, roll call vote has been requested. We are still looking for three absent members. We are still...I...I heard the request for regular order first, from Senator Lindsay, so roll call will be in regular order. Senator Fisher, Senator Schrock, Senator Landis. Senator Beutler has authorized us to go ahead, it is his amendment, so we will proceed with the roll call.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1389 of the Legislative Journal.) 21 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is not agreed to. Call is raised. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler, I believe you have the next amendment, AM1246.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I'd pull it, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER WITHEM: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I believe I have nothing further pending to AM1246, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: We are discussing the adoption of the amendment, LB 1246 (sic). Is there any discussion? Seeing none, Senator Jones or Senator Wickersham, one or both of you are recognized for closing. I believe it's Senator Jones's amendment. Senator Jones, you are recognized to close.

SENATOR JONES: Chairman and members of the body, we've had a long discussion on this and I hope we can come down to a vote on my amendment we started on yesterday.
