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SPEAKER WITHEM: One minute.

SENATOR LANDIS: ... (inaudible) are inappropriate, then you have, I think, exactly the kind of argument that says this is unnecessary. And do we really have to pass a bill just to show our allegiance to a political agenda? I don't think so. If there's a pattern of abuse, get it up here and let's take a look at it, examine it. Can't use the horse, knee-deep in brush, that doesn't apply. This bill's not going to help that. Let's get another example here before we do this if... otherwise we are simply passing another law. Wouldn't we make that as one of the things that people don't like about government, passing unnecessary laws? Sure it is. And in this case I think this bill qualifies in that capacity.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Landis. Senator Jones, I neglected to implement a portion of the rules. As the principal introducer of the bill, you are authorized to speak in response to the kill motion initially. Do you have a response?

SENATOR JONES: Yes, I already... didn't I already say that I'd take it up?

SPEAKER WITHEM: Yes, you did, but after the... after the speech opening on the indefinitely postpone motion comes forward then you have an opportunity to speak on the kill motion itself.

SENATOR JONES: Yes, right now me and Senator Bernard-Stevens have been talking a little bit here about something else. But I do want to talk against the kill motion right now, and I want to take it up. I think that we should go ahead and vote on it today, if we possibly can, because I think the language we've got in the bill is maybe not the way we want it, but that's the way that it ended up. I think that we're just... what we're trying to do here today is look before you leap, and I think that's the main thing that we're trying to do. And I think Senator Jensen did bring out that remark here earlier, that we should really look before we leap on something like this because it could be a taking, and that's where we want to go.
