And I'll leave that offer open if the amendment is...if this motion is agreed to, that I'd be willing to introduce it with you, or whomever you'd like to have introduce it as a resolution. I've checked with Senator Chambers and others and there's not nearly the opposition to and statement of the intent of the Legislature on taking rather than putting it in the statute. And in closing, members of the body, I don't do this lightly because we all have things that we care deeply about. But I think as we've looked at the debate one of the conclusions I've come up with, and Senator Landis was instrumental in clearing my thought process on this particular matter, is this bill doesn't do...bring us any further on what Senator Jones is trying to do in regards to takings than we already have now. And it's time the Legislature moves on, it's time that we move on and say, look, we understand that it didn't do that much, we've got a good debate on it. We can have a resolution tomorrow, we can pass the resolution when it's scheduled for debate on...for the intent, send it to who we wish and we can make a very strong statement of intent. But I think it's time now that we do move on and I would hope that we would go for the resolution tomorrow and indefinitely postpone this bill at this particular point. Thank you.
