SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the closing. All in favor of adopting the committee amendments indicate by voting aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Committee amendments are adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any discussion on the motion to advance? Senator Hall, to close, or did you want to open first?

SENATOR HALL: Thank you very much. I would just urge advancement to E & R Initial of LB 509. If there are concerns that individuals have, I'd be happy to deal with them between now and Select File. I believe that with the adoption of the committee amendments, any concerns that the auditor had are incorporated or taken care of with regard to the legislation and I would urge its advancement to E & R Initial. Thank you.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the advancement of 509.
