SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: But we'll be glad to take a look at it before Select and maybe we can say that it either has to be or something, because I agree, I also had problems with that, Senator.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Schellpeper and, Senator Wesely, thank you very much. Senator Vrtiska, your light is the last.
