

they were not able to qualify. Senator Day's bill merely said that if they are a nonprofit organization that otherwise qualifies for a historical vehicle that they can use the historical vehicle process and be allowed to have that plate. And there was genuine interest in doing this in the committee and we put those bills together long before we heard about consent calendar. So, with that, I would urge the adoption of the committee amendments. If either Senator Beutler or Senator Day...Senator Day, I see is shaking her head, I would like to yield part of my opening time to Senator Day, and when she is done if Senator Beutler would like the rest of it to explain the bill, I would certainly do so.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Senator Day, approximately eight minutes.

SENATOR DAY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and thank you, Senator Kristensen. I just want to explain where this came from a little bit so you understand. It was our Kiwanis Club in Norfolk has an antique fire truck and they came to me and they would like to have that licensed as an antique but because the Kiwanis Club did not own another vehicle they were unable to do this. And, after doing this, I know there were some historical societies too that also own vehicles that were unable to license them as antique vehicles. So it's a very simple amendment to this to take care of just a small area but I think it's good policy. Thank you.
