

SENATOR DAY: Thank you, Madam President, the amendment on the fiscal note decreases the fiscal note. There was allowed in there \$5,000 for personnel services which we were able to discuss with the department and they will do it with their current personnel so it drops it down so the only thing that will...the only expenditure out of cash funds will be for changing of the rules and regulations and sending them out and I would urge your adoption of the amendment.
