

Revenue Code of 1986 as amended. We cannot, we cannot simply adopt a provision which incorporates all future changes in the Internal Revenue Code, that is an improper delegation of powers. We're simply working out a mechanism through this bill and then subsequent bills, which I anticipate to be introduced each year to keep us current with our statutory references. And there is a provision in the bill that gives a common definition of the Internal Revenue Code, so we'll be able to shorten up our references, and it should, all in all, be a more efficient way to proceed and utilized primarily by bill drafters. Once we pass the bill you'll hardly ever recognize the significance or see it operate. Thank you.

CLERK: Madam President, 451, a bill introduced by Senator Engel. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 17 of this year, referred to the Health Committee, advanced to General File. I have committee amendments pending by the Health and Human Services Committee.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Chair recognizes Senator Matzke to open on the committee amendments.

SENATOR MATZKE: Madam President and members of the Legislature, this bill authorizes the Department of Social Services to adopt rules and regulations to license Native American foster care homes located outside the limit of reservations. All the committee amendments do is harmonize the terminology changes made by the Legislature in another bill, in LB 401, that's on Final Reading. I would request the adoption of the committee
