PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Robinson to open on the committee amendments.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Madam President, members of the body, LB 772, this bill deals with the granting a utility easement in Wahoo. The committee amendment adds a little different and more accurate legal description of the property involved and also adds the emergency clause to the bill. I urge your adoption of the committee amendments.
