PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Preister, your light is on. Do you wish to speak to the Janssen amendment? Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body, I agree with the premise of AM1175 of Senator Janssen. The language looks like it's a lot and that's only because it's drafted as an amendment to 37. The original bill I think only added operator in there because of the circumstances that have been described adequately by Senator Janssen and Senator Chambers. I think it was an oversight in some previous drafting of statute and this is probably the appropriate time to make the necessary corrections in language. Thank you, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Senator Lindsay would like to announce that the following guests are visiting the Legislature today, Pam Hoover from Millard South is here with her students and visiting foreign exchange students from Dortmund, Germany with their sponsor. They are all in the north balcony. Will you stand and be recognized, please. Welcome to the Legislature. Is there any further discussion of the Janssen amendment to LB 37? Seeing none, Senator Janssen, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the Janssen amendment to LB 37. SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President. This is AM1140. This addresses something that I had, knew about I guess and didn't think about it in drafting the bill. Senator Chambers pointed out in General File debate on the language that requires the maintenance of liability insurance during the entire period
