

I just want to make sure that, Senator Coordsen, when you close, maybe you could make sure that the intent here is that you're not talking about designees, you're talking about supervisors, sheriffs and I'm not sure who the other individual was, but I just wanted to make sure because that was the discussion we had earlier. I'll yield you the rest of my time, but the committee did get a good chance to look at this and I think a majority of the committee, if this was a bill, certainly would have had passed it out without any problem. And I'd yield the rest of my time to Senator Coordsen.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Kristensen, only very briefly in response, it takes out designation because that created another part of the problem. This, in fact, language has been ran by our major statewide law enforcement agency and it's simply the supervisory law enforcement officer which would be reflected by the patrol, the police chief or the county sheriff, no designees, so that's...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you. I think that clears up my question, Senator Coordsen. I want to make sure that, because one of the printed versions we had designee, but this would be fine. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Senator Jones.

SENATOR JONES: Madam President and members of the body, I sit on the Transportation Committee too and we did discuss that in exec meeting for a length of time and I understand it and I think there is a problem here or it could be a problem, so I stand in support of Senator Coordsen's amendment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Jones. Is there any further discussion of the Coordsen amendment? Seeing none, Senator Coordsen, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the Coordsen amendment to LB 37. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.
