PRESIDENT ROBAK: There has been a request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The house is under call. Will senators please return to their seats. Will all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Will senators please check in. We are accepting call-in votes. The question before you is, shall debate cease on the Wickersham amendment to the Engel amendment to LB 425.

CLERK: Senator Hartnett voting yes. Senator Schmitt voting yes. Senator Pirsch voting yes. Senator Elmer voting yes. Senator Jones voting yes. Senator Cudaback voting yes. Senator Fisher voting yes. Senator Robak voting yes. Senator Janssen, you had voted yes, Senator, I'm pleased to report, not twice.
