So I simply wanted to rise and see if by coming from a different perspective with regard to those words you could be persuaded that there is a great deal of economic activity involved in businesses that fall within those definitions.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Brashear. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, after listening to Senator Brashear, I still support Senator Hall's amendment. And I do see a very real possibility of conflict between that language, which he is attempting to strike, and some of the following language. But even though Senator Brashear argued about what the words could be interpreted to mean if we restrict their meaning, such restriction does not occur in the bill itself. So the things that Senator Hall had talked about can occur under the terms of the bill as written. I'd like to ask Senator...I'll ask Senator Brashear this question since he was the one who discussed these aspects. Senator Brashear, wouldn't you agree that the bill would allow broader...a broader sweep than what you described in your discussion, based on the way it's written?

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Senator Chambers, I really don't think so. But...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, if it says...

SENATOR BRASHEAR: ...maybe you can help me.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...if it says storage warehousing, where do we see anything that says it could not be a one-person operation, which needs some additional money to expand? Maybe they just got somebody who sits around and is like a watch person and opens these storage bins for people and things like that. That would be possible under this bill (inaudible)...
