

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, you have your fourth vote.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Engel. Is there any further discussion on the Chambers amendment? Seeing none, Senator Chambers, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the Chambers amendment to the Engel amendment to LB 425. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, I would ask for a call of the house and I'll accept call-in votes.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: There has been a request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The house is under call. Will senators please return to their seats. Will all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Will senators please check in. The question before you is the Chambers amendment to the Engel amendment to LB 425. We are accepting call-in votes.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chambers amendment is adopted. I raise the call. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Chambers would move to amend. Senator, this is the amendment found in the Journal, page 1508.
