SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, at this point I want the opportunity to look at...

CLERK: You're amending Senator Wickersham's amendment from yesterday, striking lines 8-10. There were two of them that you had printed, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And I wish...is Senator Wickersham excused?

CLERK: No, sir.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do I have other amendments because if so, I would pass over, because that's a substantive amendment, until he comes back.

CLERK: You do.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, I'll take...

CLERK: Next amendment I have is by Senator Chambers. Senator, page 2, line 6 of Senator Engel's amendment strike the word "such" and insert the words "no other". (Amendment appears on page 1515 of the Legislative Journal.) Page 2, line 6.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President and members of the Legislature, Senator Engel, I hope you will look at this amendment with me because it is on page 2 of your amendment, and the present language says, the fund shall be appropriated for such purposes, referring to all that went before. What I would do is strike "such" and put "no other" which would say, the fund shall be appropriated for no other purposes, to make it clear that these funds are to be used only for the things we have described in this bill. When we lay out Senator Wickersham's amendment, there are certain specifications made. There is the reference back to Section 81-1201.09 and this sentence that I'm dealing with would be new language that your amendment adds which says, the fund shall be appropriated for such purposes. Mine would make it clear that it will be appropriated for only those purposes. It may seem like it's not saying anything and maybe it's not making that much difference, but it makes it very
