

clear that these are the only purposes for which the money is appropriated. If you say such purposes, it could be construed to mean such purposes and related things. Let me ask you this question. Would the adoption of the words "no other purposes" bother you?

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Engel.

SENATOR ENGEL: Senator Chambers, I don't believe it would. The intent of this bill, as it's being revised and written, and we're keeping the discretionary portion of it on there, as far as I'm concerned I can't see where it would make any difference.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. And, members of the Legislature, Senator Engel did give me a copy of his proposal which is now the Engel amendment that is before us and I had made some markings on it, but the bill came up before I had a chance to talk to him again. Some of these are very minor changes and I'm trying to make it crystal clear each change that I'm making, why I'm making it and acknowledging that maybe it is not that significant but it would make it very clear and precise what it is we're saying. So with Senator Engel's agreement, I'm not going to belabor this point.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Is there any further discussion of the Chambers amendment? Seeing none, Senator Chambers, do you wish to close on your amendment? Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the Chambers amendment to the Engel amendment to LB 425. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted?
