

word "policies". All I'm doing is adding "and procedures". The word policies will appear in two places in the bill, and after the word "policy", "policies" where it appears, I will insert the words "and procedures" so that the commission will establish policies and procedures. Things must be done in the bill pursuant to the policies and procedures. Then where the number of employees is talked about, and this is strictly a matter of semantics, instead of saying "less" than this number, it would be "fewer" than. We're talking about the number of employees rather than a quantity and we've all agreed to this so I will ask that you adopt it, but in order that you're aware, if any of you are still conscious, I would ask Senator Engel this question.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Engel.

SENATOR ENGEL: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Engel, have I correctly stated the situation when I said you agreed to this amendment.

SENATOR ENGEL: You definitely did, yes, we accept it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, and I would ask that we adopt it.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Engel.

SENATOR ENGEL: Getting everything ironed out in this bill, I hopefully so because when we started this discussion several days ago, I talked about being up in the air in my little airplane, still on my solo flight and I am running low on gas. I've got to come down. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Engel. Is there any further discussion on the Chambers amendment to the Engel amendment? Seeing none, Senator Chambers, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the Chambers amendment to the Engel amendment to LB 425. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.
