

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: It is intended to be 25 percent of whatever is in the fund at that time because it isn't appropriate to talk about a \$6 million appropriation or a \$3 million appropriation because there is also a revolving fund element.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. With that having been stated, I'm going to leave the amendment before us for a while longer in case somebody else wants to address their feelings about this particular aspect of the bill.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Bohlke wishes to announce that the following guests are visiting the Legislature this morning. There are 50 fourth graders and their sponsors here from Alcott Elementary School in Hastings, Nebraska. Will you all stand and be recognized, please. Welcome to the Legislature. Senator Engel, I had told you that I would work with you on this bill and that's what I've tried to do, but at no time did I say I support the philosophy of the bill and I hope I... I don't think I've misled anybody. These types of bills are not the kind that I agree with, but I have said on this bill and others, that if we're going to do something, we ought to try to put it in the best form that we can. Between now and Select File perhaps a white copy will be put in our bill books and made available to us so we can see exactly the form the bill is in by virtue of the amendments that we have adopted. I still am concerned about the size of the companies and I will try to do some work with reference to that aspect of the bill. But if every amendment that I'd offer would be adopted, there is no way I'd support this bill. Now I have to immediately qualify that.
