SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR HALL: So then the...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I can walk you through section by section quickly here.

SENATOR HALL: No, I'm more interested in the amendment because if we move it to...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yeah, what the amendment does.

SENATOR HALL: Because then it really would be a county revenue assistance act at that point. But if you could take me through the amendment, I'd appreciate it because...especially the back side, I mean, that shows up on page 1506.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: The first thing it does, Senator Hall, if you look at the green copy...

SENATOR HALL: Right.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Section 3 on page 3, basically, it creates the fund and it strikes the rest of that amendment. It just says that the fund shall consist of money appropriated from the General Fund...

SENATOR HALL: Correct.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: ...period. You strike the rest of those lines down through 18...

SENATOR HALL: Right, any money in the fund available...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: That's the boilerplate, if you've got any
