LB 19A, 19, 240

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Any further discussion on the Hudkins' amendment? Seeing none, Senator Hudkins, would you like to close? She waives closing. The question is the adoption of the Hudkins' amendment to LB 240. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill? Senator Maurstad.

CLERK: You need to readvance, Senator.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: I'm sorry, I'm still in shock. Let's see, I'll move to advance LB 240 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LB 240 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. I've been asked to announce that in observance of Public Health Week the Department of Health, the Nebraska Department of Health and Lincoln-Lancaster County Health are sponsoring informational displays on the first floor of our building. And today, Friday, April 7, there are cholesterol and high blood pressure screening and health risk assessment offered for legislators and staff between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. And if you would like to take advantage of that, that's one way you can join in observance of Public Health Week. Thank you. We will continue to LB 19A.
