SENATOR CROSBY: The motion carries. Senator Kristensen. Mr. Clerk, any...go ahead, Senator Kristensen, on your amendment.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Madam President. It is just as I stated in my motion to return. I'd ask the body to adopt this amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Any discussion on the amendment? Seeing none, Senator Kristensen. He waives off on closing. The question is the adoption of the Kristensen amendment to LR 3. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted. Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I would move to advance LR 3 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LR 3 to E & R for engrossing. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, with respect to LB 300, I have two motions. Senator Hall would move to return the bill for specific amendment. (See FA131 found on page 1541 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Madam President and members. The amendment is a technical change that we did not catch; if you would open your Final Reading copy, it was passed...the amendment was passed out here on the floor earlier during the debate on the previous bill. It is on page 2. The bill, as you remember, was unopposed. It dealt with the issue of the deductibility for purposes of Nebraska income tax of charitable deductions. This amendment merely takes, in line 20, where...in line 21, the word "contributions". We used charitable contributions in the first half of the change in the statute, and then in the second half we talk about charitable deductions. All we do is strike "contributions" and insert "deductions" so that the language used in the statute is uniform, so that there
